

Measure C Carpool Program Prize Eligibility Guidelines

Measure C Carpool Program is for NEW and EXISTING carpoolers. Carpools are subject to verification by Measure C staff. Participants may be eligible for a monthly \$1,000 cash prize and each entry will be eligible for a grand prize at the program's one year anniversary in July 2010. To earn an entry in the Monthly \$1,000 Cash Drawing and the annual Grand Prize Drawings, participants must read and agree to the following:

PRIZE DRAWING ELIGIBILITY Rules

1. Participants must register at www.valleyrides.com. All information must be complete and accurate.
2. Registrants must carpool with one or more other persons at least twice a week. *A week is defined as seven commute days (Sunday – Saturday)*
If you need a carpool partner, sign up on www.valleyrides.com and find a match today!
Commuter Vanpools not currently receiving Measure C funding are eligible to participate in this program. For more information on vanpool incentives, go to www.valleyrides.com and click on the Vanpools tab, or call 559-441-RIDE. Participants must commute to work or school.
3. After registration, you'll immediately receive a confirmation email with a link to the Commute Log Report.
4. If you do not receive your confirmation, call 559-441-RIDE. It is your responsibility to ensure that Valleyrides.com receives and confirms your registration.
5. Every participant must complete and submit online Commute Log Reports at least one time per month to qualify for the monthly cash drawing. Each completed and submitted log counts as one entry.
6. Each carpool member must submit separate Commute Log Reports to qualify for the monthly and year-end drawings.
7. If you switch carpool partners during the program, you must revise your online registration information. The new carpooler must register to be able to submit his or her own carpool log reports.
8. A carpool partner's ineligibility DOES NOT affect the existing carpool participant's eligibility status.
9. Participants must be at least 18 years of age.
10. Driving children to school or day care does not qualify for the incentive.
11. Measure C Carpool Program drivers must have a valid driver's license.
12. Measure C Carpool Program participants must commute to or from Fresno County.
13. The annual program begins July 1, 2009 and concludes June 31, 2010, or until prizes are depleted.
14. Each individual weekly Commute Log Report will qualify as one entry into the monthly \$1000.00 cash drawing. Each entry will also be entered in the Grand Prize drawings held in July 2010.
15. Participants who win a \$1,000 monthly drawing may still be eligible to win drawings during the remaining months. There are no limitations as to how many times you may win!

Measure C Carpool Program Rights

1. Measure C has the right to terminate the Carpool Program with or without notice at any time for any reason.
2. All information supplied by the participant shall be correct, current and complete. Measure C has the right to refuse applications and/or discontinue participation in the program,

including the right to withhold the award if we believe that the participant has failed to meet any of the guidelines.

3. We reserve the right to contact you, your carpool partner(s) and your office supervisor to verify the information provided. We also reserve the right to visit your place of employment, school, or park and ride location at any time during your participation, but will not disrupt your place of business or your work day.
4. If a dispute arises regarding any aspect of the program, regarding rule interpretation, accuracy of the information, or eligibility to participate, Measure C staff will be the final decision makers regarding such a dispute and all decisions will be final.
5. By participating you are granting Measure C and Valleyrides.com the right to use your name, photograph, quotes, video, and likeness for public relations purposes.

Awarding Measure C Carpool Program Giveaways

1. A winner is defined as an individual who was randomly selected to receive a Measure C Carpool Program giveaway. A winner is not defined as the entire carpool or any group of, or all carpool members, in a verifiable carpool.
2. It is the participant's responsibility to submit contact information changes (home address, work address, e-mail, home phone, work phone, etc.) that occur during and after the registration and commute log submittal process in order to facilitate fulfillment of the prize.
3. Winners must participate in an awards presentation and agree to allow the Measure C Carpool Program staff to photograph them during the awards presentation. By participating you are granting Measure C, Valleyrides.com, and their implementing agencies the right to use your name, photograph, quotes, video, and likeness for public relations purposes.
4. All prize recipients must complete a W-9 form and submit it to Measure C Carpool Program and Council of Fresno County Governments staff before receiving their prize/s.
5. Failure to submit complete and accurate information as requested from the Measure C Carpool Program Registration and Commute Log submittal processes and on the W-9 form can result in forfeiture of Measure C Carpool Program prizes.
